## CATATAN

1. Susunan Keutamaan Persekutuan dalam Jadual Pertama hendaklah diikuti dalam semua Majlis Rasmi Persekutuan.
2. Raja-Raja dan Yang di-Pertua bagi Negeri-Negeri mengambil keutamaan antara mereka sendiri mengikut Perkara 70 Perlembagaan Persekutuan. *Butiran 3 dan 4.*
3. Orang yang dikurniakan Darjah Pangkuan Negara, Darjah Setia Mahkota, Darjah Jasa Negara atau Darjah Setia Diraja mengambil keutamaan dalam tingkatan mereka masing-masing mengikut tarikh pengurniaan. Ahli-ahli Kehormat mengambil keutamaan selepas semua ahli penuh. *Butiran 9, 12, 35, 42, 54, 55, 61, 62 dan 63.*
4. Anggota Kumpulan Diplomatik mengambil keutamaan antara mereka sendiri berdasarkan tingkatan mereka masing-masing dan kelaziman diplomatik. *Butiran 31.*
5. Presiden Mahkamah Rayuan, Hakim Besar Mahkamah Tinggi di Malaya, Hakim Besar Mahkamah Tinggi di Sabah dan Sarawak, Hakim Mahkamah Persekutuan, Hakim Mahkamah Rayuan, Hakim Mahkamah Tinggi dan Pesuruhjaya Kehakiman mengambil keutamaan antara mereka sendiri mengikut seksyen 8 Akta Mahkamah Kehakiman 1964. *Butiran 18, 19, 20, 32, 33, dan 41.*
6. Menteri Besar dan Ketua Menteri mengambil keutamaan antara mereka sendiri berdasarkan keutamaan Raja-Raja dan Yang di-Pertua bagi Negeri-Negeri mereka, apabila mereka hadir bersama Raja-Raja dan Yang di-Pertua bagi *Butiran 17A.*

Negeri-Negeri. Walau bagaimanapun sekiranya Menteri Besar dan Ketua Menteri hadir tanpa kehadiran Raja-Raja dan Yang di-Pertua bagi Negeri-Negeri, mereka mengambil keutamaan antara mereka berdasarkan berdasarkan tarikh pelantikan masing-masing.

7. Setiausaha Parlimen dan Setiausaha Politik mengambil keutamaan antara mereka sendiri berdasarkan keutamaan Menteri mereka. *Butiran 34 dan 65.*
8. Pegawai Gred Utama Turus I, II dan III, pegawai Gred Utama 'A', 'B' dan 'C', dan pegawai Gred 54 dan 52 mengambil keutamaan antara mereka sendiri berdasarkan tarikh pelantikan mereka. Pegawai Perkhidmatan Awam, Tentera dan Polis mengambil keutamaan antara mereka sendiri dalam tingkatan mereka masing-masing berdasarkan tarikh kemasukan mereka dalam tingkatan itu, dengan syarat bahawa penyandang jawatan memangku mengambil keutamaan antara mereka sendiri selepas semua penyandang jawatan hakiki dan kontrak dalam tingkatan yang sama. *Butiran 36, 38, 39, 56, 58, 60, 64 dan 66.*
9. Ahli Dewan Negara dan Ahli Dewan Rakyat mengambil keutamaan antara mereka sendiri berdasarkan susunan yang ditetapkan oleh Yang di-Pertuan Agong. *Butiran 47 dan 48.*
10. Pengerusi Suruhanjaya yang ditubuhkan di bawah Perlembagaan Persekutuan mengambil keutamaan antara mereka sendiri berdasarkan tingkatan mereka masing-masing dan tarikh pelantikan mereka. *Butiran 40.*
11. Naib Canselor Universiti, Pengerusi Badan Berkanun Persekutuan dan Ketua Badan Berkanun Persekutuan mengambil keutamaan antara mereka sendiri berdasarkan *Butiran 56, 57, 58, 60 dan 64.*

12. Seseorang yang berhak kepada lebih daripada satu tempat dalam Jadual Pertama mengambil keutamaan mengikut tempat yang lebih tinggi, misalnya seorang Pengerusi Badan Berkanun Persekutuan yang juga merupakan ahli Panglima Mangku Negara, mengambil keutamaan sebagaimana yang dinyatakan di butiran 35 dan bukannya di butiran 56.
13. Tertakluk kepada catatan 12, isteri mengambil keutamaan sama seperti suami mereka dan suami mengambil keutamaan sama seperti isteri mereka.
14. Orang yang tidak disebut dalam Jadual Pertama akan mengambil keutamaan mengikut kelaziman yang ditetapkan tertakluk kepada apa-apa panduan khas sebagaimana yang diberikan oleh Jabatan Perdana Menteri dari semasa ke semasa.
15. Jika timbul apa-apa keraguan tentang pemakaian Jadual Pertama, rujukan hendaklah dibuat kepada Jabatan Perdana Menteri atau, berkenaan dengan butiran 31, 59 dan 67, kepada Kementerian Luar Negeri.

## SECOND SCHEDULE

(Paragraph 2)

## NOTE

1. The Federal Order of Precedence in the First Schedule shall be followed in all Federal Official Functions.
2. The Rulers and Yang di-Pertua Negeri of the States take precedence among themselves in accordance with Article 70 of the Federal Constitution. *Items 3 and 4.*
3. Persons awarded to the Darjah Pangkuan Negara, Darjah Setia Mahkota, Darjah Jasa Negara or Darjah Setia Diraja take precedence within their respective grades according to the dates of the awards. Honorary members take precedence after all full members. *Items 9, 12, 35, 42, 54, 55, 61, 62 and 63.*
4. Members of the Diplomatic Corps take precedence among themselves according to their respective grades and diplomatic usage. *Item 31.*
5. President of the Court of Appeal, the Chief Judge of the High Court in Malaya, the Chief Judge of the High Court in Sabah and Sarawak, Judges of the Federal Court, Judges of the Court of Appeal, Judges of the High Court and Judicial Commissioners take precedence among themselves in accordance with section 8 of the Court of Judicature Act 1964. *Items 18, 19, 20, 32, 33 and 41.*
6. Menteri Besar and Chief Ministers take precedence among themselves according to the precedence of their Rulers and Yang di-Pertua Negeri for their States, when they are present with their Rulers and the Yang di-Pertua Negeri for their States. *Item 17A.*

However when the Menteri Besar and Chief Ministers are present without the Rulers and the Yang di-Pertua Negeri for their States, they take precedence among themselves according to their dates of appointments.

7. Parliamentary Secretaries and Political Secretaries take precedence among themselves according to the precedence of their Ministers. *Items 34 and 65.*
8. Staff I, II and III officers, Grade 'A', 'B' and 'C' officers, and Grade 54 and 52 officers take precedence among themselves according to their dates of appointments. Officers of Public Services, Military and Police take precedence among themselves within their respective grades according to the dates of their entries into the grade, provided that the holders of acting appointments take precedence among themselves after all holders of substantive appointments in the same grade. *Items 36, 38, 39, 56, 58, 60, 64 and 66.*
9. Members of the Senate and Members of the House of Representatives take precedence among themselves according to the order assigned by the Yang di-Pertuan Agong. *Items 47 and 48.*
10. Chairman of Commissions established under the Federal Constitution take precedence among themselves according to their respective grades and dates of appointments. *Item 40.*
11. Vice-Chancellors of Universities, Chairman of Federal Statutory Bodies and Heads of Federal Statutory Bodies takes precedence among themselves according to their respective grades and dates of appointments. *Items 56, 57, 58, 60 and 64.*

12. A person who is entitled to more than one place in the First Schedule takes precedence according to the highest place, for example a Chairman of a Federal Statutory Body who is also a member of Panglima Mangku Negara, takes precedence as specified in item 35 and not item 56.
13. Subject to note 12, wives take the same precedence as their husbands and husbands take the same precedence as their wives.
14. Persons not mentioned in the First Schedule will take precedence in accordance with established usage subject to such special guidance as may be given by the Prime Minister's Department from time to time.
15. If any doubt arises as to the application of the First Schedule, reference should be made to the Prime Minister's Department or, in respect of items 31, 59 and 67, to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
